Parabiblical Terminology

(i.e., significant terms when dealing with texts that exist on the boundaries of scriptural canon formation in early Judaism and Christianity, see the presentation of Dr. Annette Yoshiko Reed, http://ccat.sas.upenn.edu/psco/year40/areed1.html)

scripture: authoritative texts believed to contain divine truth

canon: lit., "rule" or "standard": a fixed list of texts

Apocrypha (big "A"): texts included in various ancient scriptural collections, but not included in the rabbinic canon

apocrypha (little "a"): lit., "secret" or "hidden texts": text written and circulated as Scripture, but not included in the canon

pseudepigrapha: works ascribed to a character or characters from Scripture

targum: lit., "translation": an Aramaic translation (or, often, a more free-form paraphrase) of a biblical book

Masoretic text: the established text of the TANAK, as set by medieval rabbis (circa 1000 CE)

pesher: interpretation of scriptural texts to find their present-day relevance or message
